








Map of the Kongo Kingdom





Mbanza Kongo (Salvador, Angola), from Olfert Dapper's Description of Africa, 1688.






Yombe peoples (Democratic Republic of Congo), *Royal scepter,* 19<sup>th</sup> century. Ivory.


