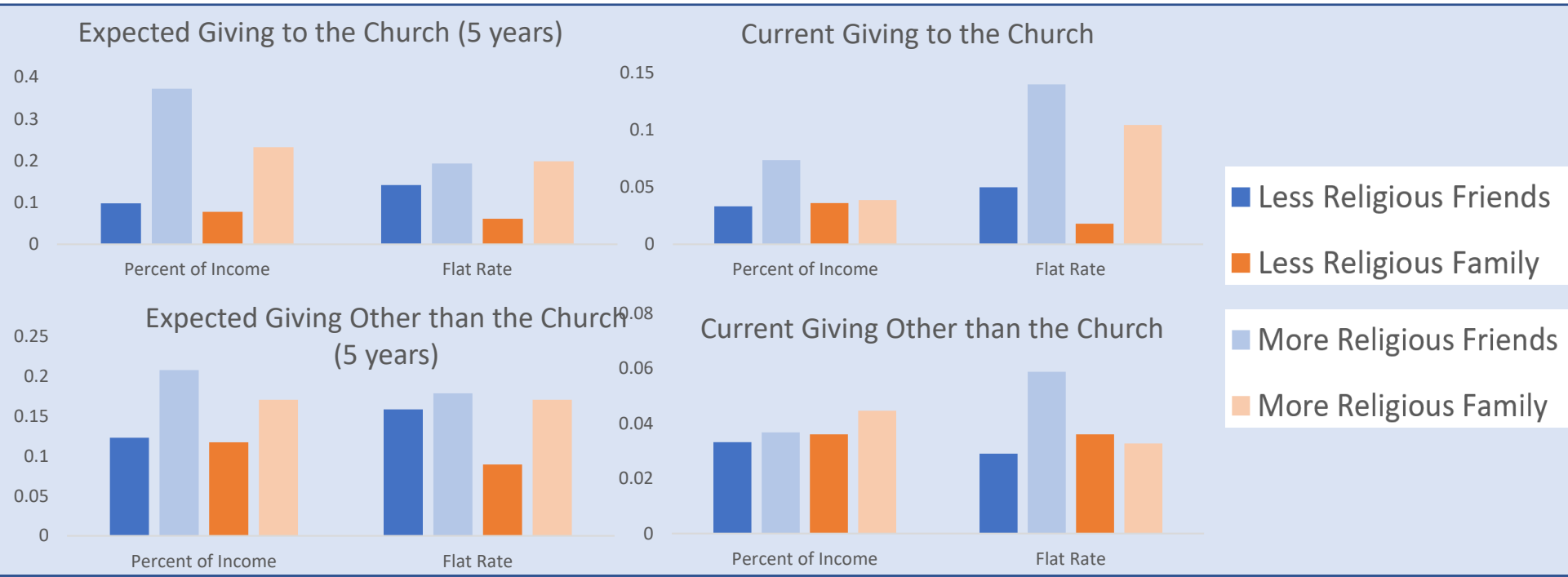


Religious peers greatly effect charitable giving and service behavior related to the church and only minimally effect giving and service behavior not associated with the church

Charitable Giving

1. Religious friends influence current and expected charitable giving more than religious family
2. Expected charitable giving is more effected than current charitable giving
3. Religious influences effect current and expected giving to the church much more than giving not to the church



Service Behavior

1. Overall, the amount of service partaken by students is minimally effected by the religious involvement by friends and family. (gave food, volunteering outside the church, helping friends all very similar)
2. However; when examining only service through the church, those who have more religious friends and family volunteer significantly more than those who do not.

- # Times in last 6 months
- 1 – Never
 - 2 – Once or Twice
 - 3 – Once a month
 - 4 – 2/3 times a week
 - 5 – Weekly
 - 6 – Several times a week
