DKU Humanities Research Center's Citizenship Lab invites proposals from students in the Class of 2023 working on Signature Work (SW) projects related to citizenship. Grants will be provided for individual as well as team-based projects. Where needed, assistance will be provided in identifying SW mentors.

The Lab will provide funding up to 5,000 RMB for SW-related expenses, including:

- Experiential learning activities (e.g., travel expenses related to fieldwork)
- Purchase of datasets, books, and project materials
- Production costs for exhibitions and/or audiovisual performances
- Conference participation
- Costs related to website design and construction

The application has three parts. (1) A brief statement (500-1,000 words) explaining how the research engages with a citizenship-related theme. (2) A one-page budget including a rationale for proposed expenses. (3) The existing SW project proposal.
