

Click Participants. It's with an icon that looks like two people centered at the bottom of your screen.





- Click Raise Hand. You'll see this on the right side of the pop-up window.
 - Without notifying or disrupting the entire meeting, you'll notify the host that you have a question or comment.
 - You can also use the keyboard shortcut, which is Alt + 'Y for Windows and Opt + Y for Mac. Click
 Lower Hand to signal that you don't have a question or comment.[1]

Using the Mobile App




- **Open Zoom and join a meeting.** This application icon looks like a video camera inside a blue circle that you can find on one of your Home screens, in the app drawer, or by searching.
 - You might have an invite to a meeting in your email or have a link or code that you can use to join an ongoing meeting. Refer to How to Use the Zoom App for more information.







- Tap Raise Hand. You'll see this as the middle option in the menu that slides up from the bottom of your screen.
 - Without notifying or disrupting the entire meeting, you'll notify the host that you have a question or comment.
 - Tap the button again to lower your hand.



- **Go to https://zoom.us/ and join a meeting.** If you don't have access to the desktop client or the mobile app, you can join a Zoom meeting using the web client in any web browser.
 - You might have an invite to a meeting in your email or have a link or code that you can use to join an ongoing meeting. Refer to How to Join a Zoom Meeting on PC or Mac for more information.



2 Click Participants. It's with an icon that looks like two people centered at the bottom of your screen.
