Friday 8/29

Morning

- Hotel → Duke Rubenstein Library (Chapel Drive)
 - Departure times: **9am, 9:20am, 9:40am** | ****[Sign up](#) for a shuttle time****
 - Guests can also take the C1 Campus bus (details below)

Evening

- Duke Rubenstein library → [Vin Rouge](#) (2010 Hillsborough Rd; corner of 9th street)
 - Departure times: **6pm, 6:20pm**—first come, first served; guests can also use Uber/Lyft
- Vin Rouge → Hotel
 - **Shuttle unavailable; options include:**
 - walk along Duke East Campus (1 mile, ~25 min; [walking directions](#))
 - call an Uber/Lyft
 - take public bus 11/11B (boards at Green St. at Iredell St.; [map](#))

Saturday 8/30

Morning

- Hotel → Duke Rubenstein Library (Chapel Drive)
 - **Shuttle unavailable**—take the **C1 Campus bus** (directions below)

Evening

- Duke Rubenstein library → Prasenjit's Home (see email for address)
 - Departure times: **6:15pm, 6:45pm**—first come, first served; can also use Uber/Lyft
- Prasenjit's Home → Hotel

Duke Campus C1 Bus (live map: duke.transloc.com)

Conference presenters may walk from the hotel to the Duke East Campus bus loop (~9 min) and take the C1 bus directly to Rubenstein Library. The bus runs every 10 minutes; no fee or ID is required.
