ποτί	= Attic πρόσ
ἕζω	to sit
-θεν	as a suffix means "from"
ἡδύς, -εῖα, -υ	sweet
γλυκύς, -ύ	sweet. comparative = γλυκίων, -ον
πένθος, τό	pain of mind, sorrow, grief
νέος, -η, -ον	young, youthful (cf. Eng. new)
ποιμήν, -ενος, ὄ	shepherd; π. λαῶν shepherd of the people (of kings)
ὔμμες	see our favorite paragraph in Benner's grammar, §110
μόρος, ὄ	~ ἡ μοῖρα, due measure, what is allotted
λίσσομαι	entreat
δειλός, ή, όν	coward
ἐπιτέλλω	command
