## Core Course Exemption Request Form

If a student has taken one or more courses at another university that are substantially similar to a MEM core course, they may apply for a course exemption; however, course exemptions are not guaranteed. If approved, the student still must complete a minimum of eight courses at Duke University to earn the Master of Engineering Management degree. That is, for each core course exemption granted, an approved technical elective must be completed, in addition to the four required technical electives.
