Evaluation/Results

- What were the outcomes?
- Barriers or Challenges?
- How was it measured?

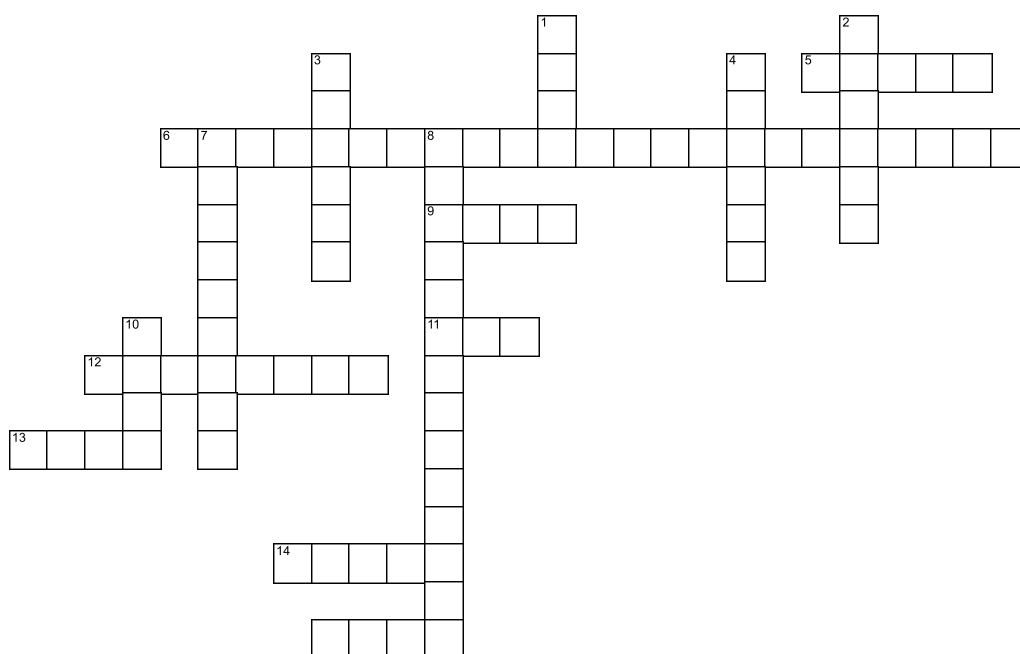
Discussion/Implications for Practice
