

We are taking inspiration from open-source problem solving and student-professor co-creation models to create a space for authentic connections, feedback loops, and a classroom community.


WHAT IS OPEN DESIGN?

Open Design is a deeply empathetic practice that leverages the power of experience to create disruptive solutions. It is a methodology of human-centered design that is derived from open source software practices, which, like Open Design, place emphasis on transparency and sharing of information.

Central to the process of Open Design is the concept of co-creation, or inviting stakeholders to the table to design alongside Open Design practitioners with the aim to design a solution that is both desirable and effective. Ultimately, this method centers the voices of users and has the potential to create radical change.

This year, Open Design+ is focusing on how to transform learning at Duke in light of COVID-19.
