Abstract

This summer, I joined a group of researchers for the Activate Good Cause Wiki, a program run by the nonprofit Volunteer Center, Activate Good. The **Activate Good Cause Wiki** is a collaborative community project whose aim is to build a central information hub about issues local to the Triangle; this project aims to serve as a critical learning resource to educate and empower the Triangle community in post-pandemic recovery and resiliency efforts.

FOOD DESERTS – KEY FACTS (1,2)

- Nationally, 25 to 30 million Americans live in food deserts
- In North Carolina, one in every five is "food insecure."
- At least 349 food deserts across 80 counties, impacting over 1.5
 million of North Carolina residents
- Low-income residents and rural communities
- are particularly burdened by food deserts

AFFORDABLE HOUSING – KEY FACTS (3,4)


- The US is facing an affordable housing crunch, which has been worsening since the pandemic struck.
- According to the Join Center for Housing Studies, nearly one in three households spend more than 40 percent of their income on housing.
- In North Carolina, 24% of renter households are extremely low income
